Anil Kakani is Senior Advisor for India at the U.S. Department of the Treasury where he leads the new U.S.-India Economic and Financial Partnership. Prior to this position, for over five years he was Director at Corning, Incorporated, a global R&D leader, for commercial development and innovation in India. With Corning, Anil established relationships with many of India's industrial leaders and policy officials for the development of Corning's long-term plan to deliver new inventions in telecommunications, clean energy and drug research to partners and customers in India. Before joining Corning, Anil served as legislative counsel to Senator Hillary Rodham Clinton in the U.S. Senate (2001-2004), and as senior advisor to the Director of the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) during the Clinton Administration (1997-2000). While at OMB, Anil traveled to India as part of President Clinton's delegation in 2000. Anil has a public policy degree from Harvard University's Kennedy School of Government and a law degree from the University of Arizona. In his spare time, Anil serves as a member of the board of directors of The Energy and Resources Institute (TERI), North America, and as Chairman of the Commission on Human Rights for the District of Columbia.
